During COVID-19 we are supporting the Government direction to undertake social distancing measures. During this time our worship service is released on St Mark's YouTube Channel at 9.30am each Sunday.

This weekend (Saturday July 25<sup>th</sup>/ Sunday 26<sup>th</sup>), we will be holding two rites of Holy Communion, face-to-face in our church. To ensure the health of our state, each other, and our community, when we gather together again, there will be some restrictions in place in accordance with our following of the Industry COVID Safe Plan for Places of Worship in Queensland.

*This includes:*

- Physical Distancing (1.5m between household groups)
- Hand Hygiene (Washing hands or using alcohol-based sanitiser)
- Respiratory Hygiene (Coughing or sneezing into elbow)
- Contact Tracing (Members will need to sign-in prior to the service)
- Frequent environmental cleaning and disinfection.

*By signing the form on arrival, you will be acknowledging that:*

- You do not have any symptoms associated with COVID-19 (e.g. Fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, sneezing/runny nose or loss of sense of smell)
- You do not have COVID-19 nor are you awaiting the results from being tested for COVID-19
- You have not been in contact with any known or suspected cases of COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- You have not returned or been in contact with anyone else who has returned, from overseas, or a COVID-19 Hotspot in the past 14 days.

We are very mindful of ensuring we are following all regulations and protocols to ensure that we provide a safe place for you to worship, but also to ensure we are able to continue to worship into the future as well, so we ask that you please respect and respond appropriately to all ushers and their instructions at all times. God bless you as we continue to navigate these difficult times to the best of our ability.
