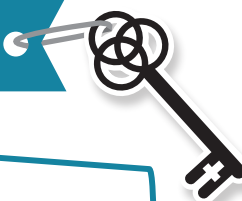


Daily Bible Readings

- What commitments would you like to make for reading the Bible and to prayer in 2018?

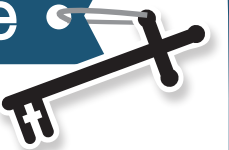
Finish this time of
