Creative Response

Try some of these ways to express your love to others this week:

- Write 'I love you' notes and place them in surprising places (e.g. school lunchboxes, under pillows or plates, in purses or wallets)
- Place a flower or small treat on the seat of a car before someone leaves for work or school.
- Make heart-shaped coupons to give to one another (e.g. shoulder massage, extra story book reading, a walk or play together, a cuddle, act of service)
- Write notes of appreciation, thanks and support on cut out hearts. 'Post' these into paper bags with each person's name on them. At the end of the week distribute the bags and enjoy reading your notes of love.
